Poster Preparation Guidelines

- Size: B1 (70x100 cm)
- Layout: vertical
- The content of a poster should include: title of the work, names and surnames of the authors, authors' affiliations, introduction, aim of study, materials and methods, results and conclusions.
- The organizers will provide boards for presentation of the posters during the conference. The boards will be located in the corridors in the immediate neighbourhood of the lecture rooms where individual sessions will take place.
- Posters should be placed on the boards according to the numbers allotted in the conference programme (e.g. P1, P2) in a given session. The authors are responsible for putting the posters on the boards before the session and removing them once the session has terminated. The organizers do not take responsibility for the posters left on the boards after the session.
- The poster session is one of the elements of the International Conference *Current Approaches to Health and Diseases in Animals and Humans*, therefore the authors of individual posters are obliged to be present by the poster while the conference participants will have an opportunity to ask questions and hold a discussion about the content of individual posters.
